Each stone is crafted with meticulous detail and texture, closely mirroring the appearance of natural stone. In a 100 square-foot area, the weight ranges from 10 to 12 pounds per square foot. You have the option to mix and match different styles (such as Ledge, Cobble, Field, etc.) to create a customized pattern.

All products are backed by a 50-year limited warranty when installed according to the manufacturer's guidelines. They are suitable for both indoor and outdoor installations.

Please note that the colors shown in this brochure may vary slightly from the actual product.

When calculating surface area for your project, it's important to account for a potential material loss of 5 to 10%. However, for installations without mortar joints using Ledge Stone, Cobble Stone, or Ledge/Cobble Stone, plan for up to 12% loss. For outdoor installations, we still recommend using mortar joints for the best results.
